



## SCHOLARSHIP FOR UTILITY LINE PROGRAM

We are pleased to advise high school students or any high school graduate living within our service area or in areas within our service territory outer boundary, who may be interested in continuing their education, that the Custer Public Power District will offer a scholarship to any Vocational or Community College for the tuition of a Utility Line Program.

### Scholarship Guidelines

1. Scholarship Amount: Year 1 - Full tuition.  
Year 2 - Full tuition, *contingent on successful completion of 1<sup>st</sup> year.*

Succeeding semester tuition to be paid only *upon successful completion of preceding semester with submission of passing GPA to Custer Public Power District.*

Apply early there may be a waiting list at each of the colleges.  
Scholarship preference will be given to accepted students.

2. One scholarship to be offered annually per scholarship winners. Preference will be given to individuals who reside within Custer's service territory.
3. Applicant must be a High School Graduate.
4. **Deadline for scholarship applications is March 1.** A selection from the applicants will be made following a scheduled interview, if needed, prior to March 15. A first and second alternate may be designated.
5. The applicant must use Custer Public Power District's Scholarship Data Form, which may be obtained from any participating high school, or from Custer Public Power District's main office in Broken Bow, NE.
6. Selection of two students will be made by the Custer Public Power District Scholarship Selection Committee. Custer Public Power District reserves the right to reject any or all applicants.
7. Disbursement of scholarship funds will be made directly to the participating Vocational or Community College and is *non-transferrable to another college*. Funds will be credited for tuition only. ***A statement from the college will be required for funds to be dispersed and a passing GPA record will need to be submitted at the end of each class session.***
8. **A copy of the selected applicant's completed registration form to one of the approved schools must be made available to Custer Public Power District by May 15.**

It is mutually understood that if the scholarship is not used by March 1 of the year following the award, then it becomes null and void.
