We are pleased to advise high school students or any high school graduate living within our service area or in areas within our service territory outer boundary, who may be interested in continuing their education, that the Custer Public Power District will offer a scholarship to any Vocational or Community College for the tuition of a Utility Line Program.

Scholarship Guidelines

1. Scholarship Amount: Year 1 - Full tuition.
Year 2 - Full tuition.

Succeeding semester tuition to be paid only upon successful completion of preceding semester.

2. One scholarship to be offered annually.
3. Applicant must be a High School Graduate.
4. The applicant must use Custer Public Power District's Scholarship Data Form, which may be obtained from any participating high school, or from Custer Public Power District's main office in Broken Bow, NE.
5. Selection of one student will be made by the Custer Public Power District Scholarship Selection Committee. Custer Public Power District reserves the right to reject any or all applicants.
6. Disbursement of scholarship funds will be made directly to the participating Vocational or Community College. Funds will be credited for tuition only. A statement from the college will be required for funds to be dispersed.
7. Deadline for scholarship applications is March 1. A selection from the applicants will be made following a scheduled interview prior to March 15. A first and second alternate may be designated.
8. A copy of the selected applicant's completed registration form to one of the approved schools must be made available to Custer Public Power District by May 15.
9. Preference will be given to individuals who reside within Custer's service territory.
